Featured App: Choiceworks

Choiceworks is a great new app that helps children with special needs regulate their behavior, follow their daily routine, make choices, and understand how to control their feelings and impulses. It has three key boards: schedules, waiting, and feelings. There are professionally recorded voices that accompany the 165 included images, however the app allows for endless customization because personal photos from the iPad can be included and sounds can be recorded from the iPad itself. At 14.99\$ it is on the pricier side of education apps, but it is a valuable learning tool that we think is worth it!

Free app of the month- Put it away!

Put It Away is a great new “game” app that helps children learn where things go in the house (and “secretly” helps them learn categories of items in a fun way!) The best part about this free app is that it allows the user to create new scenes with user uploaded pictures and items so you can upload pictures of your own house and help the kids learn to clean up!
